How to get the tables we need to process the ASP analysis

- Log in to Secure Access and go to ASP. If you do not have access to the ASP, you will need someone to grant this to you.
- 2) When logged in you should see something like the picture to the right.
- Select the phase (for example 'Key Stage 2'), then select
 'Explore Data in Detail' or 'View Pupil Breakdown'. -----
- You should then see the table we need showing the performance of each group (KS2 Reading Sample below).
- 5) You can copy this table into a Word document, or straight into an email.
- 6) We will need the following tables for the full analysis (unless you require less phases):
 - KS2: Combined, Reading, Writing and Mathematics
 - KS1: Reading, Writing and Mathematics
 - Year 1 Phonics
 - EYFS for a full report for the EYFS, we need both tables shown below (they can be copied in one go).


