What is a suffix?

A letters or letters added to the end of a root word.

They can change the word class.





inform adore prepare admire confuse invade





inform

adore

prepare

admire

confuse

invade

They are all verbs.

You know they are a verb, because you can add the word 'to' before them.





information adoration preparation admiration confusion invasion





information adoration preparation admiration confusion invasion They are all nouns. Adding ation or sion to a verb makes them a noun.

You know they are a noun, because you can add the word 'the' before them (be careful with this tip as you could have an adjective before the noun too: eg the blue dog)





sad complete usual right final

They are all adjectives. They describe a noun.

Note: Sometimes the spellings need to change, for example if the root word ends -ic, then -ally is added eg: automatic - automatically





sadly completely usually rightly finally

Now they are all adverbs. They add more detail to a verb.

Add -ly to change an adjective to an adverb.

Note: Sometimes the spellings need to change, for example if the root word ends -ic, then -ally is added eg: automatic - automatically
