Connectives can also be grouped based on what they are needed for. For example:

Time connective: whilst

Water was gushing into the ship's hull, whilst the captain panicked. whilst is used because there are 2 things happening at the same time

Result connective: therefore

All the lifeboats had been used, therefore many people died. therefore is used as something happens as a result of something else

Explaining connective: for example

The children found division difficult, for example they forgot the remainders for example is used because there is explanatory information

Addition connective: and

The boy walked down the street and to the shop.

and is used because there is additional information
