What is a **P**refix?

Prefixes are different to suffixes in 2 ways:

- 1) They go at the start of a word
- 2) They have a meaning

For example:

unwell **anti**dote
 disable **mis**take

Other common prefixes: What meaning do they have?

trans- **sub-** **inter-**
tri- **ex-** **auto-** **micro-**
