

To order numbers with decimals

Steps to Success


- 1) I can count in decimals 0.1 to 1
- 2) I can put decimals in order

Count in steps of 0.1 Count in steps of 0.1 starting at a whole number. Where do these fractions go on the decimal line?






Decimals work in tenths. $\frac{1}{10}$




Then
$$\frac{1}{100}$$

And 100 hundredths to make a tenth. $\frac{10}{100} = \frac{1}{10}$

And 100 hundredths to make 1. $\frac{100}{100} = 1$





So, when ordering, always start at the biggest number (eg hundreds H). If it is the same, move to the next number. Remember, TENTHS are bigger than HUNDREDTHS.
