

To find the perimeter of rectangles

Steps to Success:

- 1) To know that perimeter is 'The distance around the whole shape'
- 2) To measure each side accurately, then add together.
- 3) To use double the sides to save time (for rectangles only).
- 4) I can find the perimeter of a compound shape




Perimeter = 5+2+5+2 = 14cm or (double the sides): 10cm+4cm = 14cm



Perimeter is the distance around a shape Use the ruler to measure the sides, then add them together.





We can save time by doubling

$$30cm + 10 cm = 40cm$$

Compound shapes make you think!!!!! Tip: 3cm In rectangles, opposite sides are equal. 5cm 3cm 10cm

Can you work out the missing sides? Then calculate the perimeter.
