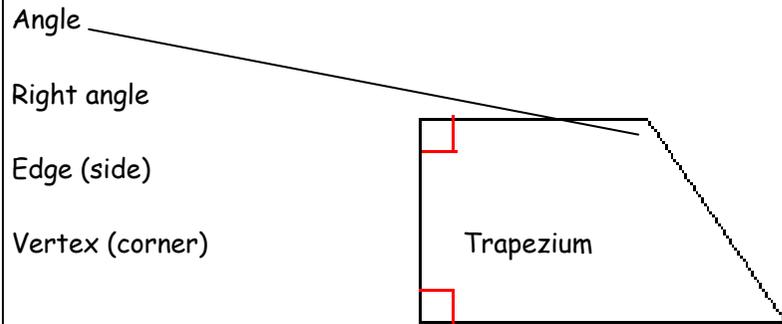


To draw properties of shapes

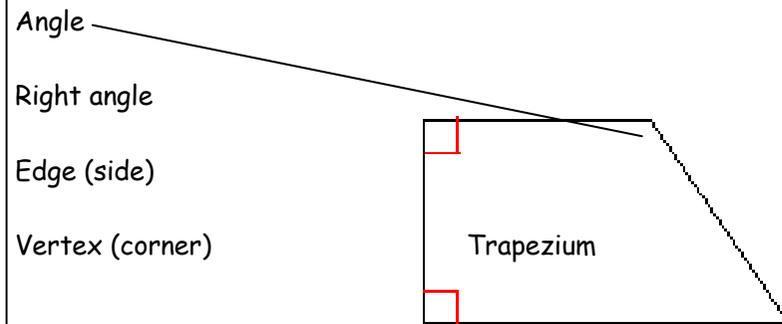
