Pronunciation of real words and pseudo-words

Some of the graphemes used in the check represent a number of different phonemes. When decoding a real word in the check, the child has to select the correct phoneme for the word, for example the 'ow' in 'blow' should not be pronounced as the 'ow' in 'cow'.

The tables on the next page provide guidance on some examples of common pronunciations of the pseudo-words in the check. When decoding a pseudo-word, all plausible alternative and regional pronunciations are acceptable.

Section 1: When decoding a pseudo-word, all plausible alternative and regional pronunciations are acceptable.

Pseudo-word	Acceptable pronunciation	Phonemic representation
dup	This item uses the 'd' from 'dig' and rhymes with 'cup'.	/dʌp/ or /dʊp/
hib	This item uses the 'h' from 'hill' and rhymes with 'bib'.	/hɪb/
gox	This item uses the 'g' from 'gap' and rhymes with 'box'.	/gɒks/
ags	This item uses the 'a' from 'at' and rhymes with 'bags'.	/ægz/ or /ægs/
yech	This item uses the 'ye' from 'yell' with the 'ch' in 'check' or 'school'.	/jetʃ/ or /jek/
quog	This item uses the 'qu' from 'quiz' and rhymes with 'smog'.	/kwɒg/
loip	This item combines the 'l' from 'leap' with the 'oi' from 'boil' and the 'p' from 'loop'.	/lɔɪp/
chuss	This item uses the 'ch' from 'chick' and rhymes with 'fuss'.	/tʃʌs/ or /tʃʊs/
clen	This item uses the 'cl' from 'clap' and rhymes with 'then'.	/klen/
stizz	This item uses the 'st' from 'stick' and rhymes with 'whizz'.	/stɪz/
pult	This item combines the 'p' from 'park' with the 'u' from 'gulp' and the 'lt' from 'melt'.	/pʌlt/ or /pʊlt/
heeft	This item combines the 'h' from 'hair' with the 'ee' from 'keep' and the 'ft' from 'swift'.	/hi:ft/

Pseudo-word	Acceptable pronunciation	Phonemic representation
jigh	This item uses the 'j' from 'jump' and rhymes with 'high'.	/dʒaɪ/
saunt	This item uses the 's' from 'seeds' and rhymes with 'taunt'.	/sɔ:nt/
virp	This item uses the 'v' from 'void' and rhymes with 'chirp'.	/vɜ:p/ or /vɜrp/
phope	This item uses the 'ph' from 'photo' and rhymes with 'scope'.	/fəʊp/
sleft	This item uses the 'sl' from 'slant' and rhymes with 'theft'.	/slɛft/
thresk	This item uses the 'thr' from 'throw' and rhymes with 'desk'.	/θrɛsk/ or /ðrɛsk/
spleg	This item uses the 'spl' from 'split' and rhymes with 'peg'.	/splɛg/
strume	This item uses the 'str' from 'strap' and rhymes with 'plume'.	/stru:m/
